Transfer Student Success asked incoming transfer students questions about engagement interests, programming preferences to inform services and support provided by the Transfer Student Success (TSS). Below are the results of our findings, the TSS action plan, and how we can support units in making informed programming decisions. We share these results with the campus community in efforts to support their creation of intentional, transfer-focused programmatic plans.

All 2022-2023 incoming transfer students were encouraged to fill out the intake form via summer emails. 182 unique users filled out the form, which is about 5% of the incoming class.

FUN FACTS

50%

indicated they will be **commuting** to campus. Of which 58% indicated they will be commuting 5+ miles.

42%

indicated they will be **working** while attending UCSD. campus. Another 50% indicated they might work. On average, they plan to work 11 - 20 hours per week.

40%

indicated they will participate in an **online social event** in addition to in-person options.
