Transfer Student Success asked incoming transfer students questions about engagement interests, programming preferences to inform services and support provided by the Transfer Student Success (TSS). Below are the results of our findings, the TSS action plan, and how we can support units in making informed programming decisions. We share these results with the campus community in efforts to support their creation of intentional, transferfocused programmatic plans.

## **THE PROCESS**



All 2020-2021 incoming transfer students received two emails to fill out an intake form. Reminders via social media were also posted. 389 unique users filled out the form, which is about 10% of the incoming class.


